  - b) To reduce the by-catch in trawl fishing
  - To Promote sustainable fishing by allowing juvenile to escape and grow
  - d) To provide awareness and training to fishermen on sustainable fishing practices.
  - e) To obtain MSC certification for Sardine and Villorita and ensure export value.
- 3. The Departmental Working Group (Fisheries) held on 09.06.2021 discussed the proposal in detail and approved the same subject to the condition that the data related to Kerala should be accessible to by officer of the State.
- 4. Considering the recommendations of the Working Group, Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the project Proposal for Sustainable Marine Fishing Practices (Square Mesh , MSC Certification) at an estimated cost of Rs 50 lakh (Rupees Fifty Lakh Only) subject to the condition that the data related to Kerala should be accessible by officer of the State.
